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## Infos for Parents

Each class at Oberschule am Wasserturm elects not only student representatives, but also parent representatives. These elected parent representatives from the class parents' associations will then represent the interests of the parents towards teachers, the school and in everyday and extraordinary matters and promote effective communication between the parties involved.

**The tasks of a parent representative** in this sense mainly include:

- Teacher-parent-school interface,
- forwarding information and announcements from the school and the city or state government,
- bringing questions or complaints from parents to the person(s) concerned and working towards a solution.

Every parent representative at this meeting has a **vote and the right to express their opinion on all topics** and must primarily express the interests of the parents. Ideally, the school management will take on board suggestions from parents in order to make everyday school life as satisfactory as possible for everyone.
